COVID-19 HUMANITARIAN EMERGENCY RELIEF IN KOKO KEBBI STATE

With the outbreak of COVID-19 and the attendant shutdown orders from government for many months, some poor communities experienced shortages in food, medicals, sanitary materials, food items and income. In order to save lives and improve livelihoods, the Salesians of Don Bosco facilitated the distribution of foods, sanitary items and other relief materials in the far north area of Koko in Kebbi State (northwest Nigeria). Apart from the distribution of foods and medical items, the organisation also implemented the sensitisation/awareness raising campaigns in 25 poor villages with great emphasis on personal hygiene. In support of the hygiene promotion, the organisation aided the construction of water borehole facilities at selected poor communities. With the activities implemented, over 600 families have benefited, mostly peasant farmers and jobless girls, women and children.
